







Ear savers (crochet)

*This pattern does not require a gauge or perfection. Close counts.
However, be sure to sew buttons on securely.*

Supplies:

Cotton yarn (medium/worsted), H hook, 2 buttons, needle and extra yarn or dental floss



Chain 18		
DC in 4th chain from the hook (counts as 1st DC), 5 DC in same chain space.		
DC in each chain across, leaving 1 chain at the end. (13 DC)		
6 DC in last chain.		
Working along back side of chain, dc in each ch across. (13DC)		
Join with slip stitch at top of 1st dc/ch 3. Tie off, weave in ends.		
Sew a button on each end with extra yarn or <i>dental floss</i> for super strong hold.
